ASSEMBLY

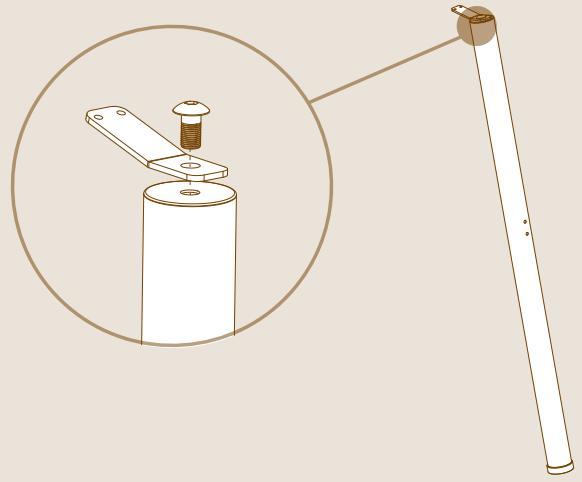
- 1 Assemble the frame by clicking the 4 plastic frame corners.



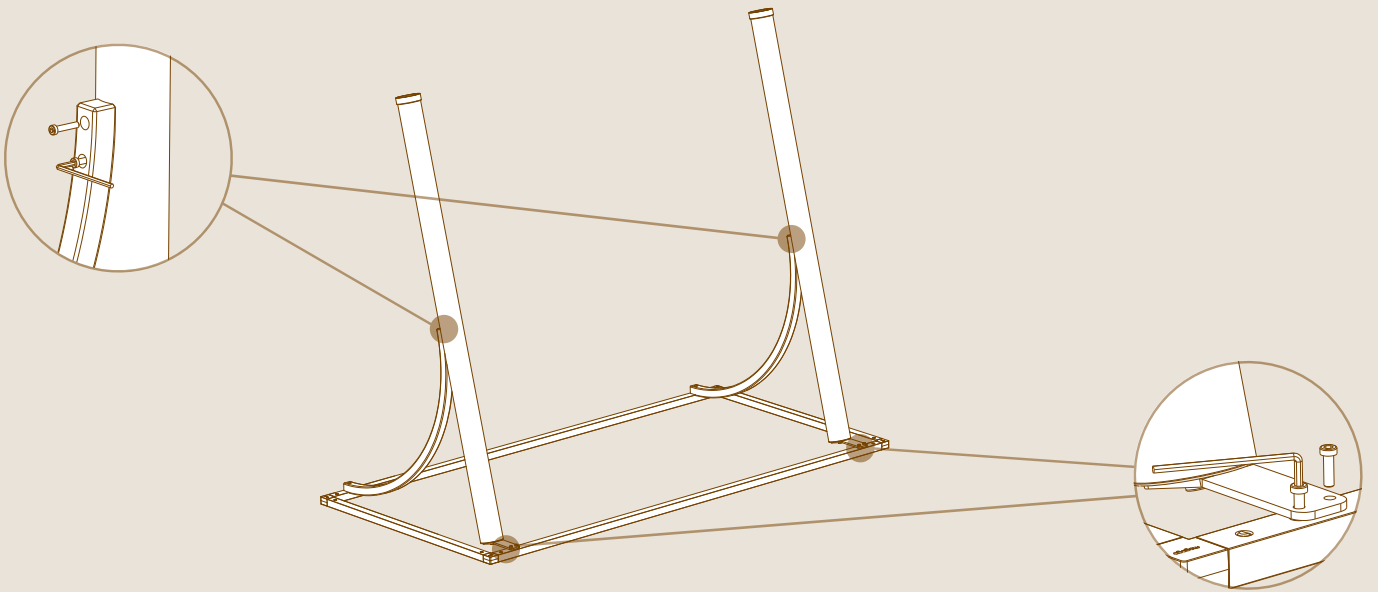
- 2 Attach the support arches to the frame on the side with the single hole.



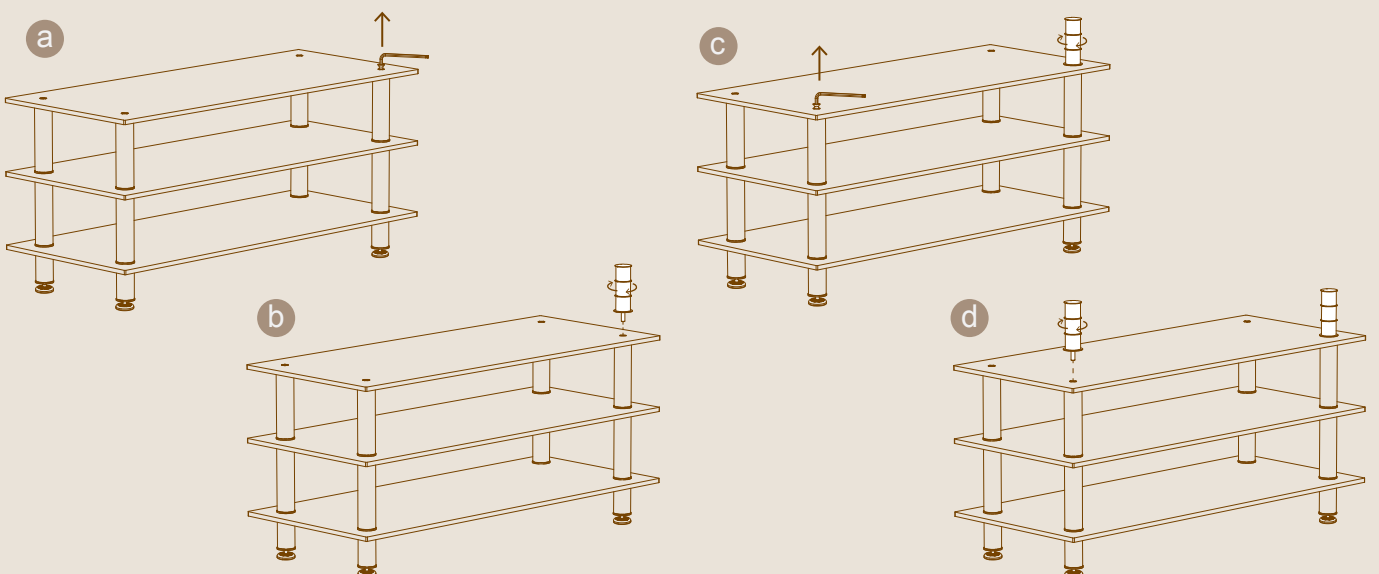
- 3** Screw on the angled connectors to the poles, as shown here facing the opposite side of the holes in the pipe.



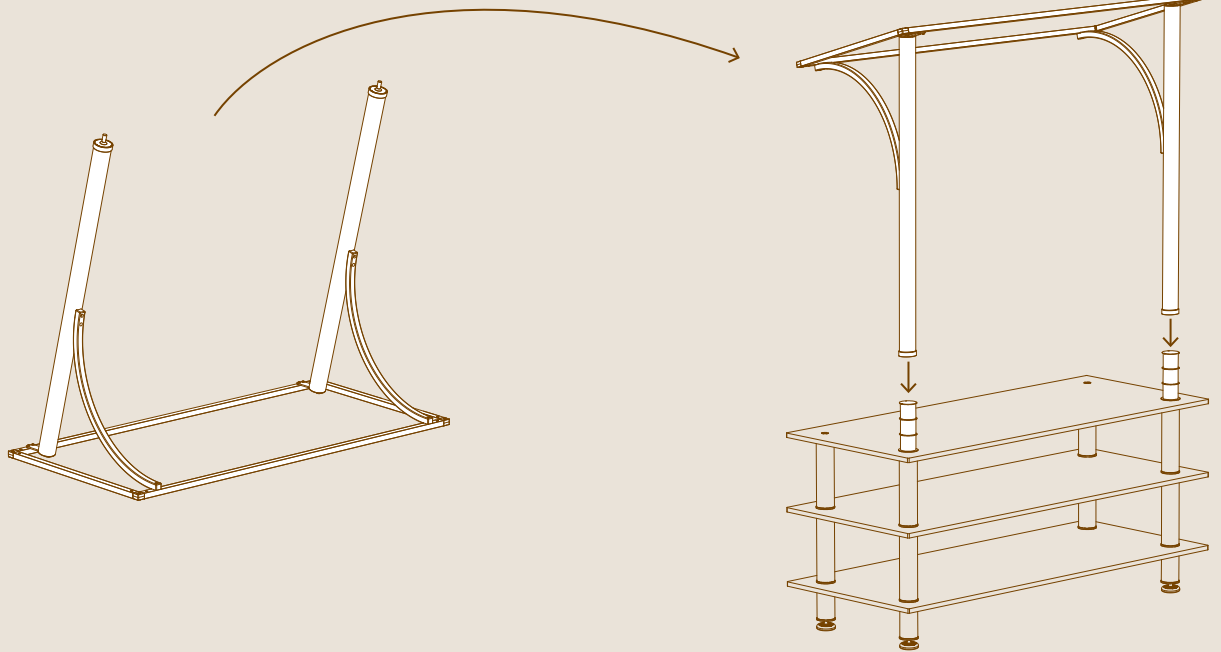
- 4** Attach the poles to the frame and to the bamboo support arches.



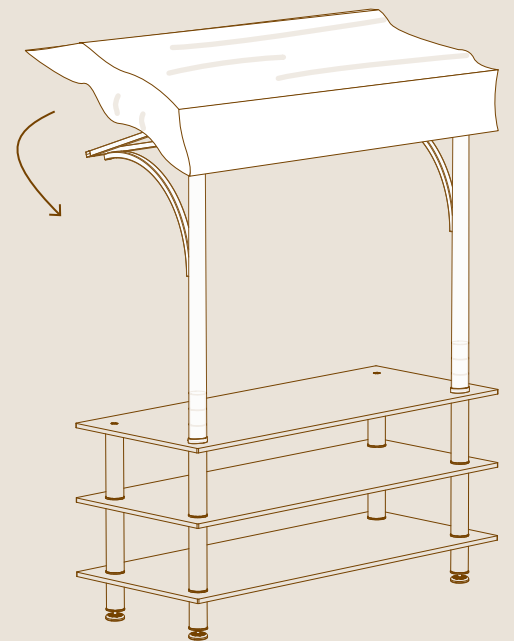
- 5** Attach the adaptors to your large unit table.



- 6** Flip the canopy base onto the connectors. With the help of an additional person, each person should hold one side.



- 7** Spread the fabric over the frame, starting with the side with the long stitches, on the highest corners of the frame.
